We believe in and actively support multicultural learning and related social integration both on campus and in the broader community.

Society Aims and Objectives:

- 1) To promote and provide free-of-charge traditional fine art drawing skills tuition through the society co-founder Alan.
- 2) To promote international fellowship through art through the meetings and activities of the society, including on-line through its website, and social and fundraising activities.
- 3) To encourage other practitioners and instructors in traditional world arts and related creative arts – such as Chinese calligraphy and brush painting, costume presentations, feng shui, etc (including music) – to share their expertise with society members and through the society, to the broader student and BU staff community through regular tuition or special events and workshops.
- 4) To work with other BU student union societies (including the Chinese Students and Scholars Association and the BU ISA), the BU Atrium Gallery, the BU Culture, Community, Music and Sport team, and also appropriate organisations in the broader community such as the Dorset Race Equality Council, Bournemouth and Poole Councils, etc.
- 5) To support appropriate women's and international women's groups / organisations through participation in such events as International Women's Day; this aim being due to the consistently high level of popularity of the society with BU female international students.
