

Bournemouth University Sailing Club

Constitution

October 2010, reviewed May 2011.

1. Name:

The full title of the organisation shall be the Bournemouth University Sailing Club. Hereinafter referred to as the 'club'.

2. Aims:

The aims of the club are to promote sailing activities for all interested Bournemouth University students and staff. The sailing club also aims to provide opportunities for it's members to compete in racing including BUCS and BUSA events.

3. Affiliation:

a) The club shall be run in accordance with the Constitution of the Students' Union of Bournemouth University

b) Where sufficient racing interest and fund are available, the club shall be affiliated to the Royal Yachting Association (RYA) through subscription to the British University Sailing Association, BUSA, and shall adhere to the BUSA constitution and the rules and regulations governing Championships and Leagues organised by BUSA.

4. Committee:

The Club committee shall consist of the following positions:

- Club President
- Treasurer
- Secretary
- Safety Officer
- Events and Equipment Officer
- Social Secretary

In the case of roles being unfulfilled or resignations new committee members may be co-opted at a committee meeting.

5. Elections:

a) Elections for club committee positions shall be held during the club's AGM and all members of the club are eligible to stand for election.

b) All candidates must complete a nomination form; forms shall be made available to all members prior to the AGM.

c) Elections will be decided by an open vote of members at the AGM.

6. AGM

The club shall hold an annual general meeting (AGM) during the summer term each year and at least 7 days notice of such a meeting shall be given to the members.

- a) The Quorum of the AGM shall be 5 members and the AGM must be quorate for any motions to be passed
 - i. In the event of an AGM not being quorate the meeting will be adjourned to a later date.
