- Plane
 - Bournemouth

Once abroad

- -Hire Vehicles
 - Check driver limitations in the country you're travelling to e.g. 25 and clean license

Accommodation:

- -Hostels
 - Cheap
 - Capacity for large groups/shared dorms
- -Airbnb
 - -Self-contained
 - -SUBU Airbnb
- -Hotel
 - -Small groups
 - -Good for access needs

- Time for Q&A's




