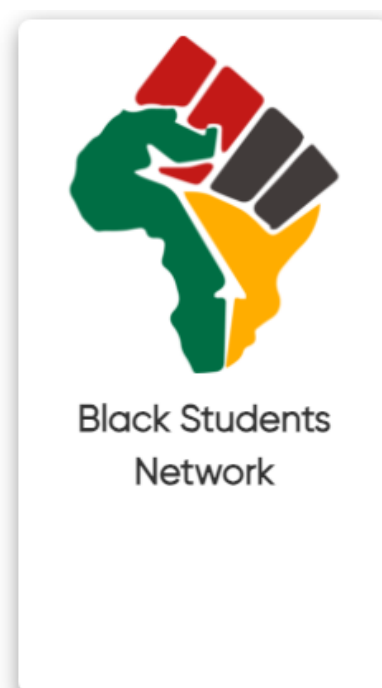


What are Liberation Networks?

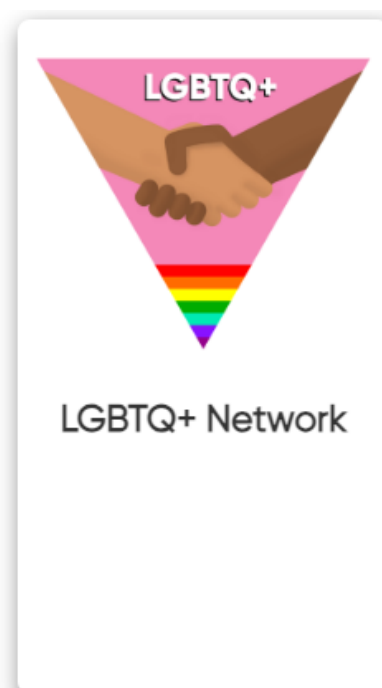
