SUBU clubs and societies are expected to be mostly financially self-sustaining with income generated through membership, ticketed events, sponsorship and fundraising. Groups can apply for a Clubs and Societies Grant to develop further and enhance what they are able to offer.

Grants are decided by a panel that meets 6 times in the academic year. This Panel is made of a SUBU Full-Time Officer, BU Students and Permanent staff.

Comment

Appeal

The awarding committee have agreed to grant the full amount for the trophies and frames, and 50% of the total cost of the meal for up to 30 people.

Breakdown of grant fund awarded:

- 2 course meal at revs: £12.50 per person, up to 30 people
- Engraved trophies: £15.16
- 12 plastic trophies £14.99
- Frames: £28

As per the grant funding document, it is unlikely for the awarding committee to award funding for socials. We are happy to award the funding on this occasion but please note it is unlikely that this will be granted again in the future, and we would encourage societies to fund their own end of year celebrations.
