What will happen to the money made from the ticket sales? Will this go back into the club account, or will it be donated? The application states this is a charity event. <p>The awarding committee are likely to award funding however this information will be needed in order to make a decision.</p> <p>Appeal 29.11.22</p> <p>The awarding committee note that the Islamic Society are hoping to have 80 attendees at the event; charging £8 a ticket would result in £640 income.</p> <p>The original application lists the items needed for the event which comes to a total of £780 which is higher than the projected income. The appeal stated that all income from ticket sales is hoped would all be donated to charity of the students' choice however as the costs of the event are not covered by the projected ticket sales there would be nothing to donate.</p> <p>In order to support the society to run the inter-faith event, the awarding committee will be granting 50% of the cost of the hall hire up to £50 and 50% of the total cost of food up to £250.</p> <p>The awarding committee would like to make the Islamic Society aware that more thought towards income and expenditure does need to be given to planning an event such as this and urge the committee to use the clubs and societies budget planner available on the committee zone here.</p>

This is a request for funding towards the Film Society's trip to the Berlin Film Festival in February. Cost breakdown: - Travel: £1,250 (Coaches to the airport and back from the airport) £3,251.70 (Flight to Berlin and back) £600.00 (Train tickets in berlin for travel to the accommodation from the airport and back on both travel days (£10 per head, 2x 24hr tickets per head)). - Accommodation: £1,884 (4 nights in Berlin) The full trip itself will cost £6,985.70 Member tickets will make up £4,800 (30 x £160) of the £6,985.70. The remaining £2,185.70 will be up of made from the £1,750 grant and £435.70 from the film society account. (This will leave us with £1,119.50 left for the general running of the society for the rest of the			

year.)

Comment

The Awarding Committee have worked out that the total amount requested is 25% of the total cost of the trip to Berlin. Therefore, will be providing grant funding to the value of 25% of the total cost of accommodation and flights. The amounts below are taken from the application;

Accommodation full cost = £1,884

Flights full cost = £3,251.70

Therefore 25% of this is £783.92

The Awarding Committee would consider awarding further funding to support the cost of the event tickets for students whilst on the trip. Please provide information on this and a breakdown of ticket costs for the Awarding Committee to make a further consideration for grant funding.
