5. IMPROVING STUDENT SUPPORT

5.1 SCL stated that extra support needed to be organised as some students are struggling

academically. Students not registered with the BU services are having issues with the workload.

More attention is needed, and extra options of support. Specifically first year students are finding it

difficult to attain credits. AMK agreed and added that the support system needs to be made known

for everyone to access

5.3. JA stated 5 steps of well-being will contribute to this issue – Also Resurface may help – students

pay a small fee and have access to services. CM stated first years need to know about what is there.

Need to let people know of these services.

5.5. GH Stated a welcome pack is being circulated and this can help spread the word. JA stated that

leaflets will be sent around and reaching out to students everywhere not just in the halls to make

students aware of the different services. All welcome to contact JA to provide support.

5.7. LG agreed, but could not see some people being able to use these services. A single place needs

to be made available so that people don't suffer in silence. All agreed that this was a good idea.

9.1. NM stated: Say My Name Campaign: to be launched next year. Knowledge of Black Students Campaigns: Also Sisters Keepers which is a safe space for black women. Also a campaign which is an

ACS, BU and black student's collaboration which is basically a black student's hub. Also collaborating

with the Liberation Officers and the FTO's.

until the following Wednesday. Released a poster campaign this week. Trans people are human too

is one of them. Pronouns are important; we begin these meetings by using them. With this series of

posters we are able to address Trans and Non-Binary basic information that people need to know.

Also a Being Trans at Uni happening this week which is a Q&A Panel happening at 5.30pm Marconi

Lecture Theatre on Monday. A panel of Trans students will be answering most frequent questions

about Trans and Non-Binary. Opportunity for people to ask questions from the audience as well. If

Bournemouth. Remembering Tran's people who have died or committed suicide, particularly

LG stated when he was Black Student Officer the conferences were not just limited to NUS. If there

was a conference in London that was of value that they could not make an alternative could be

found, is this open to Liberation officers? AB stated there needs to be justification why they want to

go for that conference. Conferences with a good rational will be accepted. This is open to everyone

and the Executive Members as well ACTION: ALL

9.6. RH stated the Disability Campaign has got a Differently Abled Fair on 5th December, local

charities and national charities will be there to inform students on health and support available and

events and volunteering opportunities. Looking for a guest speaker for Disabilities History Month 22

November – 22 December 2019. Gathering information for the 'Welcome Packs' to be launched at

the Refreshers Fair. ACTION: RH

Building. Next February there is a Chinese New Year booked on 1st floor student centre. Have

Bournemouth University have created a working group whose priority is to protect the student

experience. 326 Staff are members of UCU, 127 of those have voted for industrial action. No

obligation for those members of staff to say whether they will be on strike. Meeting where BU and

SUBU represented and asked to develop a position from representatives of what the student body

want to do to deal with the impact. Our focus is the student experience.

LG asked if another meeting will be scheduled to deal with this matter. AB stated that a pre BSM

meeting will be held on 20th November 2019 (next Wednesday) so Sam could I ask you to prepare a

brief on what our action is going to be for the next meeting. LG stated that any response has to be

immediate so that students know what is happening in advance. SLH stated that immediately (as in

tomorrow), feedback this collective position in the principle of we need to make sure that there is

really good communication and need to understand what the impact is at the faculty level for

students. Then in the follow up meeting I can give a fuller brief, and then at the BSM. ACTION: SLH
