

- NUS is an association of around 400 students' unions, representing the interests of more than seven million students.
- NUS has changed considerably over the past few years due to a restructure and is made up of two distinct organisations:
 - NUS UK – this is the campaigning and political arm of the NUS that student members are most familiar with. They run the liberation conferences, national conferences. It is this area that has been subject to an independent investigation into antisemitism. More on this on next slide.
 - NUS Charity – Charity support and resources for staff. This includes support for elections. Also includes trading deals for our commercial services. This means that we can sell items in the shop and bar at a lower rate than we would otherwise be able to.

Update on NUS and its investigation into antisemitism

- In May 2022, following recent allegations of antisemitism in addition to historic matters and broader culture, NUS commissioned Rebecca Tuck KC to lead an independent investigation.
- NUS worked closely with the Union of Jewish Students throughout the investigation.
- The KC's report describes antisemitism in the student movement and NUS states the report is "truly a difficult read for all of us but we welcome the clarity it brings to enable us to act with confidence to tackle antisemitism head on".
- NUS have developed an Action Plan to take forward the recommendations from Rebecca Tuck's report and are setting up an Advisory Panel to scrutinise the plan, which has 5 key areas of work, and oversee implementation to ensure Jewish students feel safe and welcome in every corner of the movement.
- NUS describe their Action Plan as "the next step towards earning and restoring trust with Jewish students and to ensuring they are able to feel safe and supported within NUS".
